

Making music with herbs and flowers

A turn into the driveway of Don and Nancy Condit's nursery near Hatton is like entering the Garden of Eden. The profusion of flowers, herbs and plants says welcome as only color and fragrance can.

What started out 13 years ago as a hobby greenhouse for two retired music teachers has turned into a growing business - literally and figuratively. The Condits' green-thumb magic with plants seems to extend to their business, too. Nancy smiles as she walks along in front of the greenhouses each filled with a variety of flowers, plants or herbs. "We started out with just one greenhouse and they just keep spreading. We don't how to stop. We are always adding more plants and more varieties of herbs."

Customers stopping by the Condits green-houses find hundreds of plants and herbs along with answers to questions about the care and keeping of gardens. "We are constantly studying and expanding our knowledge and are always looking for new ideas to try," Nancy says.

For two music majors who met at NDSU, learning is nothing new. "There is so much literature out there that helps us be better informed for our customers. We are always learning.

The Condit's also draw on their practical life lessons to enhance their greenhouse expertise. Don grew up on a farm near Souris, and Nancy is a farm girl from Starkweather. "Because of our farming background, we both knew a lot about that part of it. Our mothers focused mainly on vegetable gardens," Nancy said. "I never ate any vegetables that came out of a can. Everything came out of a jar of Mom's home canned vegetables." The same was true for Don.

By the time they met in college, Don and Nancy were on track for the career paths that would take them to band rooms and music rooms in schools throughout the area. They finished their teaching careers close to home. Don retired from Central Valley and Nancy retired from Northwood-Hatton, where she was also a counselor.

With their own four children raised and grown, Don and Nancy were ready to enter a new field that would yield plenty of growing opportunities. "We started out just doing flowers and having them available for sale on a low-key basis. Each year it seemed to get bigger and bigger. People were asking for specific things, so we tried to get what they wanted."

Five years ago, they added vegetable plants and then it was the herbs. This year, Nancy planted a salsa tub filled with all the ingredients need to make salsa. "It is really fun to experiment and come up with something new. Customers seem to like it and we enjoy it."

Even though the nursery is open from the first of May until about the middle of June, the work begins long before that. "Don is out here planting by February 15. About 85 percent of the plants we have are grown from seed." Translated, that means Don typically plants more than 40,000 seeds just to get the business growing every spring.

This is a labor-intense business," Nancy says. "We put in a lot of hours, but think it is worth it when we see the results." Their customers agree.

Tomato Basil Jelly

6 cups tomato juice, canned (like V8) or homemade using a variety of tomatoes

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup vinegar

1 tsp. dried basil or 1 tbsp. fresh basil 1 pkg. pectin (Sure-Jel)

4 cups sugar

Mix tomato juice, vinegar and pectin in a large pot. Bring to rolling boil. Add the sugar and bring back to a boil; boil for one minute. Skim off any bubbles. Pour into sterilized jelly jars; seal.

NOTE: This is delicious used as a dip or spread over cream cheese and served with crackers. It is also a good barbecue glaze.

## Lemon Grass and Citrus Poached Salmon

- $2\frac{1}{2}$  lbs. salmon
- 1 qt. chicken stock
- 1 qt. orange juice
- 2 cups white wine
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 2 tbsps. minced garlic
- 2 cups chopped lemon grass
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. white pepper

Cilantro Pesto

- 1 16-oz. pkg. farfalle pasta
- 1 bunch fresh cilantro
- 5 gloves garlic, minced
- 1 tbsp. white wine vinegar <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup grated Parmigiana
- Reggiano cheese
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp. cayenne pepper
- 1/2 cup walnuts or pecans

garlic, vinegar, cheese, cayenne pepper, nuts and salt. Add ¼ cup of the olive oil, and blend the pesto. Add more olive oil until the pesto reaches desired consistency.

Pour pesto into a small saucepan and warm over low heat, stirring constantly, until pesto begins to simmer. Pour over cooked pasta and toss.

All the herbs are grown organically and kept in greenhouses separate from the flowers, vegetables and other plants. The Condits only use necessary chemical treatments to protect plants from aphids.

It's true the Condits have retired from professionally making music on a daily basis. They are making melodies of a different note in their gardens along a rolling country road.

Remove skin from salmon. Cut into desired portions. In a large pot, combine chicken stock, orange juice, white wine, garlic and lemon grass. Season with salt and pepper. Bring to a boil for five minutes. Reduce heat to a low boil. Place the salmon in the poaching liquid until flaky and tender, about five minutes.

Salt. to taste  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup olive oil

Bring a large pot of water to a boil. Add the pasta, and return water to a boil. Cook pasta

for 8 to 10 minutes, or until al dente; drain well. In a blender or food processor, blend cilantro.





Keep a Food Journal— Glassman recommends keeping a food journal to track meals and snacks throughout the day to ensure you're meeting your daily nutritional needs, including recommended servings of grains, fruits, vegetables and protein. Jot down what works well and what doesn't so you have a point of reference.


