

Childhood keepsakes become grown-up treasures

The collectible piggy cookie jars keep watch over the cozy kitchen in the Delores and Jay Henrickson home in Mayville.

The two little pigs once belonged to Delores' mom, Dorothy Poehls. "When I was growing up in Finley, those cookie jars were always filled with Mom's chocolate chip cookies. She gave me one of the jars while she was still living. Then I got the other one after she died. They are very special to me and have always been a special part of my life."

There are plenty of other special parts of her life, too. One is Jay, her husband of 40 years, and another is their son, Eric. For the past two months, Jay and Eric may have been overshadowed just a little by Dawson, the Henrickson's grandson - and only grandchild. "He is so wonderful and we feel so lucky to have them close by in Fargo."

Whenever Delores and Jay have some spare time, they probably head south on I-29 to see Dawson - and his parents, Eric and Amanda. "It's nice to be able to see him often - he changes so quickly."

Spare time isn't a commodity Jay and Delores have a surplus of - she works full-time at the Goose River Bank and Jay is Director of Career Services at Mayville State University. They have lived in Mayville since 1991. Except for the four years Jay was in the Army, the Henricksons have stayed pretty close to Finley - home to both of them.

"I never thought I would live in Mayville, but we are really happy here. We have the best of both worlds. We are not too far from family and have a good selection of business resources here in town. It is a nice place to be."

The Henricksons, members of Mayville Lutheran Church, are also busy with special projects in town including Relay For Life. "I've been a volunteer with Relay since it started here ten years ago," she said. "I think it is a very important project – I find it very fulfilling."

up with a mom who loved to cook - she was known for her cooking. She taught me how to bake bread, make caramel rolls and many other things. I learned how to cook by doing, and now I cook by tasting – I don't really use recipes much."

Delores does have some special recipes she relies on - one of them is for brownies. This is a recipe from Ina Garten's "Barefoot Contessa Cookbook." "She is one of my favorite Food Network chefs. Her recipes are great."

Casseroles are also popular menu items in the Henrickson household. "Jay likes casseroles, so we have a lot of those. He likes the good, old hamburger and macaroni hotdish." Delores also likes to use slow cookers for those busy days. Eric's favorite is his mom's tuna fish casserole and her Special K Bars.

As soon as Dawson is old enough to chomp down on some "real food," Grandma's bars will certainly become something he asks for. Along with family she was a little girl. favorite dishes, Delores might have some well-seasoned words Ina's Outrageous Brownies of wisdom for her grandson. 1 lb. unsalted butter "I'd like to tell him not to sweat the little things. I would also tell 1 lb. plus 12-ozs. semisweet chocolate chips him it's up to him to make his

life what he wants it to be – not let others tell him what to do."

For at least one week a year, Delores follows her own advice. She and Jay take a week each summer and spend it at a Minnesota resort. "I sit back, relax and read a good book and do what I want. Jay likes to fish, so he does some of that. We keep it pretty simple. It's great."

As she relaxes in a lakeside chair, she might also be doing a little daydreaming. "I would love to try skydiving or bungee jumping sometime. That would be fun to try."

Dawson better watch out, he just might have to go some to keep up with his grandma when he gets a little older.

In the meantime, Delores is happy adjusting a new recipe to suit her taste or baking up a big tray of brownies.

No matter what special treats Delores is cooking up in her kitchen, there is one thing sure. She has two trusty pigs to watch over her just like they did when 6-ozs. unsweetened chocolate

- 6 extra large eggs 3 tbsps. instant coffee powder
- 2 tbsps. real vanilla extract
- 2¹/₄ cups sugar

1 ¹/₄ cups flour, divided (1 cup for batter and ¹/₄ cup in the chips and nuts)

- 1 tbsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. kosher salt

3 cups diced walnut pieces Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and flour a 13x18 by

1-1/2-inch sheet pan. Melt together the butter, one pound of the chocolate chips, and the unsweetened chocolate in top of double boiler. Cool slightly. Stir together the eggs, instant coffee, vanilla and sugar. Stir into warm chocolate mixture and cool to room temperature.

Stir together one cup of the flour, baking powder and salt. Add to cooled chocolate mixture. Toss with walnuts and 12-ounces of chocolate chips with ¹/₄ cup flour to coat. Then add to chocolate batter. Pour into prepared pan.

Bake for about 30 minutes, or until tester just comes out clean. Halfway through baking, rap the pan against the oven shelf to allow air to escape from between the pan and the brownie dough. Do not over-bake. Cool thoroughly, refrigerate well and cut into squares.

Note: These freeze well.

Lima Baked Beans

- 2 cups lima beans 1 cup brown sugar 1 cup sour cream ¹/₂ tsp. salt 1/2 tsp. dry mustard
- ¹/₂ lb. diced bacon

Soak beans overnight (couple hours is enough). Drain; add fresh water, mustard and salt; boil for 20 minutes. Drain, saving water. Combine beans, sour cream, bacon and sugar. Bake in slow oven (325 degrees) for about three hours. If beans get dry, add some of the water they were boiled in.

Note: Delores doubles this recipe when she uses a slow cooker and cooks four to five hours.

Easy Frozen Pickles

16 cucumbers, sliced thin 1 cup onions, sliced thin 3 tbsps. salt 2 cups cider vinegar 1 tsp. turmeric 4 cups sugar $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. powdered alum 1 tsp. whole mustard seeds

Combine cucumbers, onions and salt. Set aside for three hours. Rinse and drain. Mix vinegar, turmeric, sugar, alum and mustard seeds. Set aside for three hours, stirring often. After three hours, pour over cucumbers and onions. Refrigerate for several days. Put in container and freeze. Pickles are crisp and very good.

Scalloped Corn

- 1 stick margarine
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 can creamed corn 1 can whole-kernel corn; use half
- of juice from the can 1 small package corn bread and
- muffin mix

Melt margarine. Mix all ingredients and bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.


